The paper we recycle is made into a cellulose insulation for residential and commercial buildings. 85% of the insulation is made of recycled paper content. Fire retardants and stabilizing materials make up the remaining 15%.

Our product is manufactured in plants across the country. GreenFiber is a complete recycler. We collect the paper, that creates the jobs, which produces a green product.
